## c. Swimming Officials – Neil Harper

- Judges 2 course set for the 26 January 2015, at present approximately 15 candidates have expressed an interest in attending it.
- Volunteers to staff the distance events at Hengrove in January have been few and far between. So far I have had more people say they are not available than those that will be. Clubs must note that if we do not get enough volunteers, there is a real risk that these championships will not be able to go ahead. *County Admin will contact clubs to ask for officials to attend session 1.*

• Looking forward to the Blocks proper, the invitations to officiate at those events will go out later this month. It is of great concern to me that one of our major clubs appears to be attending an open meet rather than the blocks. This is bound to have an effect on the number of officials available and whether this set of the blocks can comply with licensing requirements that weekend. Neil and Keith Smith will follow this up after the meeting with the club involved and the meet manager as on an approved County blocks w/e, adjoining Counties should not accept entries into open meets.

## Appendix 1 – Swim Managers Report - Richard Tomlinson

## **Key Actions – Completed to Date (For information)**

- 1) Meet Conditions Approved by County Exec (Sep 2014)

- 3) Entries received for Session 1 and Programme issued to Clubs.
- 4) Close date for entries for Sessions 2-11: Friday 23rd January 2015
- 5) County Champion, Senior Champion and Junior Champion awards received from suppliers.
- 6) Medals not yet delivered we have sufficient stock for Session 1.

#### **Replacement Trophies: For Exec to Decision**

We have 50 trophies which are presented to individuals and teams as part the County Championships. A number of trophies are in need of significant repair. We need to introduce an annual review of the Trophies and either "retire" or replace the ones which are no longer in a good state. I recommend we replace any broken trophies with similar style new trophy (cost ~£100 per Trophy and Typical annual cost £300-500).

Decisions needed from Exec: (see item 6.a in main minutes for decisions)

(i) Replace each broken trophy with new trophy. (Y/N)

NB If we don't replace then we need to no longer present the broken trophies.

(ii) Any replacement trophy will be named for its original sponsor (Y/N)

E.g. County 100m Individual Medley the City of Hereford Trophy which has a broken handle would be replaced with a new City of Hereford Trophy.

If we don't retain the original sponsor details then we either need new sponsors or to brand all new Trophies as just GCASA trophies.

- (iii) Does the Exec wish to continue presenting the The John Clement Cup?
- (iv) Any retired trophy will be given to the last winner to keep. (Y/N)

If we don't do this then we need somewhere to display or store the old trophies.

We had excellent results at the National Age Groups in December held at the Gloucester on the 5th, 6th & 7th.

We achieved medals in nearly all of the age groups as follows:

Recreational Age Group Combinational teams: 12/u - 4th, 13/14 - 1st, 15/17 - 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Competitive Age Groups: 12/u Team 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Dominated the 13/14 age group with a 1st & 2nd in Figures and Solo, 1st in Duet and 1st in Team and 15/17 Team  $1^{st}$ .

Izy Thorpe regained the overall routine highest marks swimmer award 2014.

Following this National competition, we then had 8 girls qualify for the England Talent trials which took place the following weekend at Crystal Palace, and 6 of our girls have been selected for the 15/u England 2015 squad, and 1 for the England 2015 Talent ID squad.

We also have our club athlete Genivieve Randall who has been selected for the GB & England Junior duet for 2015.

From January we will be preparing our 15 and over athletes (seniors) for the English National Championships where we hope to regain our National Champions status.

Squad days have been arranged on 31<sup>st</sup> January, 23<sup>rd</sup> May and 20<sup>th</sup> June and skill assessment days have been arranged on 28<sup>th</sup> February, 27<sup>th</sup> June and 17<sup>th</sup> October. I would like to thank Alyson Bashford, Mary Hooper and Viv Ebbs for organising and publicising these days.
